

SUMMER SUPPLEMENTARY ACCESS ENDS

14 November 2011

State Water advises that the flows have fallen below the thresholds required for access to summer/supplementary water. Access in the Dumaresq River from Pike Creek junction to Goondiwindi Weir will end today at 12:00pm. Access in the Macintyre River from Pindari Dam to the junction ceased 9:00am Monday 14 November 2011.

Customers may still access water utilising general security, high security or stock and domestic licences.

Customers must place a complying water order using one of the following options:

At the completion of pumping supplementary water the finish reading must be notified by using one of the above methods. Failure to supply a water order and the finish reading will result in any water extracted being debited to general security accounts.

Customers are reminded that all water extracted from the river will need to be ordered without exception as per your licence conditions.
