NSW Office of Water announced today that limited periods of access to supplementary water is available in the Border Rivers

Customers wishing to access supplementary water must place a complying water order using one of the following options:

At the completion of pumping supplementary water the finish reading must be notified by using one of the above methods. Failure to supply a water order and the finish reading will result in any water extracted being debited to general security accounts.

Attached on page 2 of this notice are the access licences that are participating in the current supplementary event and are able to extract water under the announcements made today, and the total available volume that can be extracted. Water orders are to be placed using the volume provided. Customers will be individually contacted with start dates.

The volume to extract is the total combined volume that may be extracted under all announcements. Where an individual indicated that a given volume was desired and the announcement is in excess of this the volume supplied has been used.
