

GWYDIR VALLEY FLOWS

31 July 2010

State Water would like to advise that following recent rainfall, current tributary inflows continue to be monitored.

Flows will firstly be utilised to meet stock and domestic, riparian and replenishment requirements. If flows exceed these needs water will be utilised to satisfy any water orders or provide supplementary access.

Expressions of interest have been sought from users on the Gwydir River from Copeton Dam to Boolooroo Weir and on the Mehi River from Tareelaro to Combadello.

As a result of the current flows the planned September riparian flows will now be postponed until late October to early November. Customers are advised to ensure that stock and domestic requirements are satisfied during the current flows.

State Water customers wishing to extract water under access licences (including general security) are to contact State Water to place water orders on 1300 662 077.

Any customers wishing to take basic landholder rights via approved metered works must provide meter readings to State Water prior to and on cessation of pumping. Any water taken for basic landholder rights without meter readings provided will be debited against other access licences.
