

SUPPLEMENTARY WATER ACCESS FOR GWYDIR VALLEY

NSW Office of Water announced today that limited periods of access to supplementary water in the Gwydir Valley are available.

Customers wishing to access supplementary water must place a complying water order using one of the following options:

At the completion of pumping supplementary water the finish reading must be notified by using one of the above methods. Failure to supply a water order and the finish reading will result in any water extracted being debited to general security accounts.

State Water will continue to monitor the situation closely and will provide regular updates as more information becomes available.

Attached on page 3 of this notice are the access licences that are participating in the current supplementary event and are able to extract water under the announcements made today, and the total available volume that can be extracted. Water orders are to be placed using the volume provided.
