

SUPPLEMENTARY WATER ACCESS FOR NAMOI VALLEY

31 January 2012

NSW Office of Water announced today that limited periods of access to supplementary water in the Namoi Valley are available.

Customers wishing to access supplementary water must place a complying water order And provide a start meter reading and hour reading using one of the following options:

- Accessing www.statewater.com.au and logging on to your iWAS account.
- Faxing your order to **1300 871 447**
- Emailing your order to northorders@statewater.com.au

At the completion of pumping supplementary water the finish reading must be notified by using one of the above methods. Failure to supply a water order and the finish reading will result in any water extracted being debited to general security accounts.

State Water will continue to monitor the situation closely and will provide regular updates as more information becomes available.

Water orders must be placed before extracting any flows, water extracted without an order will be debited against another access licence.
