

## **SUPPLEMENTARY WATER ACCESS UPDATE FOR NSW MURRAY VALLEY IRRIGATORS, 2011 – 2012 SEASON**

06 January 2012

The NSW Office of Water has announced today that access to a period of supplementary water access would be extended to NSW irrigators in the Murray Valley.

Considerable increases to demands and transmission losses resulting from recent hot weather have impacted on flow forecasts in the Murray River system meaning unregulated conditions will be ending before the dates indicated in the unregulated flow advice issued on the 23 December 2011. Unregulated flows will now be ending on the dates for each reach shown above.

Note that the end dates shown above will be reviewed as necessary, taking into account developments in Menindee Lakes flood operations.

Irrigators with a notified history of use supplementary access license are able to access supplementary water.

Please note that normal water sharing plan rules apply as per the NSW Murray and Lower Darling Water sharing plan from 1 July 2011.

The total diversion of uncontrolled flow carry over and general security water cannot exceed 110% of entitlement for the water year.

At the completion of pumping supplementary water the finish reading must be notified by using one of the above four options. Failure to supply the finish reading will result in any water extracted being debited to general accounts.

Failure to provide this information will result in any water extracted being debited from ordinary accounts.
