

MACQUARIE FLOWS MONITORED FOR INCREASES

10 February 2010

State Water advises flows in the Macquarie catchment will continue to be monitored, however at this stage, flows into catchments have not been significant enough to allow for a supplementary event.

The area has received some welcome rain over the last few days, including 126mm at Trangie, 81mm at Dunedoo and 79mm at Wellington since Friday, 5 February 2010.

Good flows have been recorded at Coolbaggie Creek and a significant 'fresh' at Narromine and downstream. At this stage the flow at Warren will not exceed the supplementary flow target, but will approach the trigger value in the next few days.

State Water will continue to monitor levels and supplementary access will be announced if the forecast indicates triggers are to be exceeded.

The Macquarie Marshes will receive a significant boost from the rain received to date.
