

SUPPLEMENTARY WATER ACCESS FOR MURRUMBIDGEE – UPDATE

11 July 2011

NSW Office of Water announced today that further periods of access to supplementary water in the Murrumbidgee Valley are available (see page 2 for details of supplementary availability).

Customers wishing to access supplementary water must place a complying water order using one of the following options:

General security license holders can currently access without debit water in accordance supplementary access announcements remembering that account limits (carryover plus allocation plus no-debit take equals 1ML/share) cannot be exceeded.

At the completion of pumping supplementary water the finish reading must be notified by using one of the above four options. Failure to supply the finish reading will result in any water extracted being debited to general accounts.

State Water will continue to monitor the situation closely and will provide regular updates as more information becomes available.
