

SUPPLEMENTARY WATER ACCESS EXTENDED FOR MURRAY VALLEY IRRIGATORS

13 January 2011

The NSW Office of Water has announced today that an extension of a period of supplementary water access would be made available to NSW irrigators in sections of the Murray Valley downstream of the Barmah Bridge and Stevens Weir.

This announcement also means that general security licence holders can no longer access 'uncontrolled flows' as the general security available water determination is greater than 60% of entitlement.

General security licence holders may continue to take water under their general security access licence.

Only Irrigators with a notified history of use Supplementary Access are able to access 'uncontrolled flow' water.

The total diversion of uncontrolled flow and general security water cannot exceed 100% of entitlement for the water year.

Customers wishing to access supplementary water must place a complying water order using one of the following options:

At the completion of pumping supplementary water the finish reading must be notified by using one of the above four options. Failure to supply the finish reading will result in any water extracted being debited to general accounts.

Failure to provide this information will result in any water extracted being debited from ordinary accounts.
