

SUPPLEMENTARY WATER ACCESS FOR NSW MURRAY VALLEY IRRIGATORS, 2011 – 2012 SEASON

20 October 2011

The NSW Office of Water has announced today that access to a period of supplementary water access would be extended to NSW irrigators in the Murray Valley.

Under continuing dry conditions with variable rainfall forecast and increasing demands, current flows in the reached of the Murray upstream of Barham, and in the Edward River system, are expected to be fully regulated by the time they reach Lake Victoria in mid November, Therefore, unregulated flow will cease in the Murray River upstream of Barham, and in the Edward River, on the dates indicated.

Irrigators with a notified history of use supplementary access license are able to access supplementary water.

This announcement also means that general security licence holders can access 'uncontrolled flows' as the general security available water determination is less than 60% of entitlement.

Please note that normal water sharing plan rules apply as per the NSW Murray and Lower Darling Water sharing plan from 1 July 2011.

The total diversion of uncontrolled flow carry over and general security water cannot exceed 110% of entitlement for the water year.

At the completion of pumping supplementary water the finish reading must be notified by using one of the above four options. Failure to supply the finish reading will result in any water extracted being debited to general accounts.

Failure to provide this information will result in any water extracted being debited from ordinary accounts.
