

GLENBAWN DAM REACHES 100% OF CAPACITY

29 November 2011

State Water advises that Glenbawn Dam has filled to 100% of storage capacity. However, the dam has a substantial flood mitigation capacity that means it can store another 16% of its capacity before it will automatically spill.

Over the next few weeks, and possibly commencing Wednesday 30 November 2011, State Water will make controlled releases up to approximately the normal peak summer releases. At these levels it is unlikely that downstream residents would be affected.

Should there be any major change to the proposed release regime State Water will advise landholders on its databases.
