

NOTICE OF MEETING WITH IRRIGATORS BEGA AND BROGO REGULATED RIVERS

State Water staff will be available on **Tuesday 23 August 2011, at 7 PM at the Bega Cheese Training Centre** to discuss water issues in the Bega and Brogo regulated rivers.

The meeting is sponsored by Bega Cheese, the Bega Water Users Association and State Water's Coastal Customer Service Committee.

At the meeting customers will be provided with an overview of water related issues for 2011-2012, including the implications of the commencement of the water sharing plan in April this year.

Specifically, customers will also be provided with advice on:

- future water availability
- how to establish internet access to their water accounts so that they can order water and monitor their usage#
- understanding how supplementary water access licences and uncontrolled flow access are managed, and how customers can best take advantage of opportunities
- water charges and IPART
- Customer Service Committees
- the state-wide metering policies
- compliance
- using State Water's call centre
