

NAMOI RIVER END-OF-SYSTEM FLOW

Under the Water Sharing Plan it is a requirement to supply an end-of-system flow at Walgett during the months of June, July and August when the combined volume of Keepit Dam and Split Rock Dam is greater than 120,000 megalitres.

As the combined volume of Keepit and Split Rock Dams is now well above this target, State Water is required to deliver the water into the Namoi River.

Scheduled maintenance is to be carried out at Mollee Weir for approximately three months starting around the middle of May. As the weir pool will be unavailable, customers needing to fill their winter requirements must insure appropriate lead times for release from Keepit dam are factored in when placing a water order.

Customers and landholders are advised to ensure that stock and domestic supplies are satisfied during this time.

Customers are reminded water orders are able to be placed through iWAS seven days a week, though orders must be placed by 8am on the required release date.

Water orders can also be faxed to 1300 871 447 or emailed to northorders@statewater.com.au Monday to Friday, and must be received by 8am on the day of required release. Orders received after 8am will be released the following day.
