

HUNTER RIVER FLOWS

5 September 2011

State Water will be making additional water releases into the Hunter River from Glenbawn Dam by the end of this week to meet increased water orders. These releases may result in minor river height increases similar to those experienced in early August.

Glenbawn Dam is currently at about 99.2% of its capacity and rain is also expected mid week.

This notice is for your information as you may be planning activities in the river. The rise will occur for about ten days.
