

PIAN CREEK REPLENISHMENT FLOW AND EARLY SPRING WATER DELIVERIES

06 August 2009

State Water will **start** the Pian Creek replenishment flow on **Friday, 7 August 2009** following consultation with the Customer Service Committee.

The release will take advantage of the current unregulated flows originating from the Peel River and the relatively cooler temperatures.

State Water anticipates this release will **continue for up to 30 days**.

Customers requiring irrigation water during August and September are advised to **place water orders now** to provide additional travel time and facilitate efficient delivery. Water orders will be **accepted up to Tuesday, 25 August 2009**.

Customer and landholders are advised to **ensure that Stock and Domestic supplies are full** as the end of system flow that has been delivered to Walgett since June will **cease** from Gunidgera Weir on **Saturday, 15 August 2009**.

State Water will consult with the Customer Service Committee next week to determine appropriate deliveries for October and November.
