

BEGA AND BROGO REGULATED RIVER Uncontrolled and Supplementary Flow Events

Following the commencement of the new water sharing plan, customers should be aware of opportunities to pump water from the Bega or Brogo Rivers.

Uncontrolled flows

Whenever allocations are less than 100% for a general security access licence, a licence holder may pump water during uncontrolled flow events without impacting on their water account. They can continue to take water providing in any water year they use no more than 100% of their entitlement, either during the event or during regulated river flows.

Supplementary flows

Licence holders with a supplementary water access licence can access the entitlement under that licence providing a supplementary flow event has been announced.

What you should know

- Be alert to event opportunities by receiving a Fax/Email/SMS from State Water – register if you have not already, and keep that registration up to date
- You must advise State Water within 7 days of when you stop pumping of your meter readings immediately prior to, and after, any event in which you pumped water – use the Fax or Email addresses below, and an internet service will be available in the next few months
- There are flow thresholds, and State Water will monitor these when advising of periods of uncontrolled and supplementary flow events
