

GLENNIES CREEK DAM UPDATE

1 February 2012

State Water advises that Glennies Creek Dam is approaching 100% of its capacity. With current inflows and with further rain, controlled releases are likely to commence again.

Rain is predicted over the next few days, but at this stage it is impossible to predict the volume of water which may inflow into the dam. Releases equivalent to peak summer flows has already commenced.

If a major controlled release is required, State Water proposes to commence the flow from 7pm on the day the release is scheduled to begin. This will provide residents with adequate warning to make necessary arrangements.
