

SUPPLEMENTARY WATER ACCESS FOR MURRUMBIDGEE - UPDATE

22 July 2010

State Water's Water Delivery Manager for Murrumbidgee Valley, Ned Hamilton announced today that further periods of access to supplementary water are available (see page 2 for details of supplementary availability). Daily monitoring of the river has improved our estimated volume and timing of supplementary water.

The supplementary water is a result of inflows from the upstream tributaries in the Tumut and Murrumbidgee River systems, due to rainfall last week.

Customers wishing to access supplementary water must place a complying water order using one of the following options:

At the completion of pumping supplementary water the finish reading must be notified by using one of the above four options. Failure to supply the finish reading will result in any water extracted being debited to general accounts.

State Water will continue to monitor the situation closely and will provide regular updates as more information becomes available.
